

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN
THE GOVERNMENT OF THE STATE OF KUWAIT
AND
THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA

1. Delegations representing the Aeronautical Authorities of the Government of the State of Kuwait headed by Mr. Sami Khalid Eid, Director of Air Transport, and the Aeronautical Authorities of the Government of the Republic of Armenia headed by Mr. Artyom Movsesyan, Director General of Civil Aviation, (herein after referred to as "Delegations"), have met in Bali, Indonesia, on 19 November 2014 to discuss matters of mutual interests in the field of Civil Aviation and to update the present framework of the Air Services Agreement (herein and after referred to as the "Agreement") between the Government of the State of Kuwait and the Government of the Republic of Armenia signed on 5th October 2011. Lists of names of the members of both Delegations are attached as Appendix (1).

2. The negotiations were held in a cordial and friendly atmosphere, and both Delegations expressed their desire to further promote their aeronautical relations in a spirit of cooperation and complete understanding for their mutual benefits.



3. The Armenian Delegation introduced the current liberalized Civil Aviation policy of Armenia, according to which any number of designated airlines from each Contracting Party, are entitled to operate any number of frequencies per week to any points, with full third and fourth freedom traffic rights with any type of aircraft, with further possibility to grant even fifth freedom traffic rights on a reciprocal basis. The Delegation of the State of Kuwait has acknowledged the introduced policy.

4. As a result of the consultations both Delegations agreed on the following:

4.1. Amendment of the Agreement:

In light of the recent developments introduced by the Armenian side, both Delegations agreed to review the Agreement in order to remove any restriction within the current Agreement that hinders the liberalization of air transportation operations between the two countries.

4.2 Frequency and Traffic Rights:

The designated airlines of each Contracting Party shall be entitled to operate any number of frequencies per week in each direction with full third, fourth and fifth freedom traffic rights with any type of aircraft for passenger/ combi/ dedicated cargo flights.




5. Entry Into Force:

Both Delegations agreed that this Memorandum of Understanding shall enter into force on the date of its signature. This Memorandum of Understanding shall supersede and replaces the relevant provisions in the previous Memorandums of Understanding signed between the Contracting Parties.


